



INVITATION TO BID

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that sealed bids will be received for solid waste and recycling services by the Commissioners of Bridgeville, 101 North Main Street, Bridgeville, Delaware, until 3:30 P.M., prevailing time, on **October 9, 2015** at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read.

All proposals must be submitted on the form provided by the Town, with said form available at the Bridgeville Town Hall or on the Town website at www.bridgeville.delaware.gov.

A Delaware business license must accompany each bid. All bids must be sealed and addressed to Mr. Jesse Savage, Bridgeville Town Manager, 101 North Main Street, Bridgeville, Delaware 19933, or may be delivered to the Town Hall between the hours of 8:30 A.M. and 4:30 P.M., except the bid deadline day. All envelopes shall have marked on the outside "Bid for Solid Waste and Recycling Collection Services".

The Commissioners reserve the right to reject any or all bids and to waive minor informalities. The Commissioners reserve the right to reject the bid of any bidder who is not, in the opinion of the Commissioners, in a position to perform the Contract.

The contract shall be for a period of three (3) years, commencing on the date of award, per the contract on **November 1, 2015** and terminating on October 31 at midnight three (3) years hence in 2018; provided however, that the Town Commissioners reserve the right to extend the contract for an additional period of one (1) year.

All municipal solid waste collected weekly, shall be deposited in a landfill approved or operated by the Delaware Solid Waste authority; and

All recycling materials collected bi-weekly, shall be deposited in a recycling location approved by the Delaware Solid Waste Authority; and

The Contractor shall be required to procure and deliver to the President of the Commissioners within ten (10) days of the awarding of the Contract, the following insurance policies to be written by a company or companies authorized to do business in the State of Delaware, the policies to be acceptable to the Commissioners:

- (1) Public Liability Insurance in which each vehicle used in the performance of the work under the contract with limits of bodily injury liability of not less than \$3,000,000.00 for each accident.
- (2) Property Damage Liability on each vehicle required in the performance of the work under the contract in an amount not less than \$50,000.00 for each accident.
- (3) Standard Worker's Compensation and Employer's Liability Insurance indemnifying the contractor against any loss arising from liability or injuries sustained by all agents, servants or employees of the contractor who shall be entitled to compensation under the worker's compensation laws.
- (4) Insurance policy indemnifying and holding the Town harmless from any and all liability, expenses, damages, etc., which may arise or be asserted against the Town because of the collection, transportation or disposal of garbage, trash or rubbish.
