



## September 2015 Town Report

### Economic Outlook:

The Town collected \$9,565.71 in building permit fees during the month of August. There were six (6) building permits issued for new construction. The Town also received a check from the Recorder of Deeds in the amount of \$36,724.68 for property transfer taxes.

### DNREC Grant- Facility Planning:

The DNREC grant application was completed and submitted for review. These funds will match the USDA grant that has been approved to plan for the upcoming upgrades to the Town's wastewater treatment facility, as required by our State permit.

### Town-wide Clean-up Day and Yard Sale:

The Town again coordinated these two events in advance of Apple Scapple.

### Town Hall Maintenance:

The back door was replaced at Town Hall. In addition, landscaping maintenance was completed along the front entrance of Town Hall. I want to extend a special thanks to all town staff involved in these two projects.

2015 Bridgeville Charity Open:

New sponsors have signed on for this year's tournament and we are looking forward to another successful event. We will again have 17+ teams competing, with many prizes to be given out. We anticipate donations to the Bridgeville Lions and Kiwanis in amounts similar to last year. Keep your fingers crossed for good weather.

CJC Grant- Closeout document:

Completed the fiscal reports necessary to close out the grant that was used to purchase taser cartridges. Submitted along with invoices to the Criminal Justice Council so funds could be disbursed.

SCAT Steering Committee Breakfast:

President Correll and I attended the SCAT Steering Committee breakfast held on September 11<sup>th</sup> in Georgetown. SCAT expects a very difficult year for State finances and all towns need to be concerned.

Sussex County Revenue Sharing Grant:

Completed and submitted the FY16 application. Funds (\$25,000) will be used to assist the Town in the purchase of a new police vehicle.

Garbage Contract:

Bid notices were advertised. Bids are due on by 3:30 on October 9<sup>th</sup> and we hope to award the contract at the October 12<sup>th</sup> Commission meeting.
