



## April 2015 Town Report

### SCAT:

Bridgeville hosted the April SCAT dinner. The meal was delicious, as always, there was a good crowd. U.S. Senator Coons and U.S. Representative Carney were the guest speakers for the evening.

### Economic Outlook:

There were four (4) building permits issued for new construction during the month of April. The Town also received a check from the Recorder of Deeds in the amount of \$103,210.71 for property transfer taxes.

### FY16 Budget:

A budget workshop was held on 4/29. Each department head had the opportunity to discuss their proposed expenditures with the Commissioners. A second workshop will be scheduled in May to cover revenues and to finalize the budget.

### New Police Department:

DBF continues to work on the layout of the building. The plan is to have something for the Commissioners to review at the June or July meeting.

### 111 Market Street:

The parking lot improvement project has been advertised. Bids are due on 5/13 @ 3:30 p.m. and they will be opened at 4:00 p.m. There is an optional pre-bid meeting on site on 5/8 @ 10:00 a.m.

Source Water Protection Ordinance:

The contractor has met with the Office of Drinking Water to iron out the details of what should be included in the ordinance. A draft should be available for introduction at the June meeting.

105 S Main:

The structures on the property were removed. There were no issues with the contractor or with the project.

Health Insurance:

I attended a State Health Benefit meeting on April 27<sup>th</sup>. The Town was informed that the rates for FY16 would be increasing by 19%. This is a significant increase that has resulted in a review of the Town's benefit package for employees.
