



August 2015 Town Report

Economic Outlook:

The Town collected \$27,134 in building permit fees during the month of August. There were eleven (4) building permits issued for new construction. The Town also received a check from the Recorder of Deeds in the amount of \$29,009.21 for property transfer taxes.

111 Market Street:

The parking lot preparation is complete. Once the dirt compaction meets our standards, the parking lot construction will begin.

USDA Grant- Facility Planning:

Reviewed and authorized paperwork completed by DBF pertaining to our grant application. Later received notice that the grant was approved. Will combine with DNREC funds to complete the planning portion of a WWTF upgrade.

Dangerous Building- 17 Church Street:

The committee that was appointed by the Commission inspected the building(s) located at 17 Church Street. A report of their findings will be presented to the Commissioners at their September meeting.

New Staff Positions:

Interviews were conducted during the month of August for the two positions. Carrie Hovatter has accepted the job as Town Clerk and Leland Damon has accepted the Water Department position. Both will begin their employment in early September.

2015 Bridgeville Charity Open:

Donations started coming in for our upcoming tournament. The contract for services from Heritage Shores was reviewed and authorized. Peggy has been working hard on getting out letters and advertisements. We are hoping for good weather and another good turnout.
