2. A review of "Hot Spots" shows a 25% decrease in the first 6 months of 2015 compared to the same time period last year.
3. We have posted 7 wanted suspects on our PD social media page which resulted in all 7 being apprehended by tips from the community and the suspects turning themselves in after seeing themselves on the internet.
