I. CALL TO ORDER

Town Manager Savage stated that it would be on the Agenda in November. Richard stated that the meeting with the State went well and that the EDC has done about 70% of what they had proposed last time. Richard discussed branding and that the EDC will be getting a website. Richard discussed fundraising and repurposing the current Police Department. Richard discussed the December 9th Christmas Parade.

IX. CITIZEN'S PRIVILEGE

William Atwood-113 Pintail Drive- Mr. Atwood stated that the Heritage Shores Military Club was able to give the USO in Dover and the National Guard Emergencies fund \$1,000 apiece. Mr. Atwood thanked everyone that contributed as sponsors. Mr. Atwood stated that Florida and Texas were receiving \$1,000 each and San Juan is receiving 1,500.
