Bridgeville Collection Station

Bridgeville has a Delaware Solid Waste Authority (DSWA) drop-off center nearby. This Station operates on a "pay-as-you-throw" basis - each bag of garbage or yard waste costs \$1.00. To protect the safety of the operator and the users, **NO cash transactions** take place on-site. Pre-paid tickets must be purchased in advance, which are available in \$10.00 increments online at dswa.com or in person at regular DSWA facilities. They are also available at the Sussex County Administration Building in Georgetown. Tickets expire one year from the date of purchase.

The Bridgeville Collection station offers a convenient and relatively inexpensive option for disposing of household garbage/yard waste. Bridgeville Town Hall does not have these tickets.

Code Department

2019 Business License: All Businesses must register with Town Hall and pay the annual fee of \$100. If your business is within town limits then you must fill out the application but do not have to pay the fee.

Snow: Shoveling Snow/ice must be removed within twenty-four (24) hours of it ceasing to accumulate, according to Town Code. The owner or occupant of any building or lot abutting a public sidewalk is responsible to keep it clear of snow/ice. Additionally, in order for your letter carrier to provide you with uninterrupted service, residents must clear the approach to their mailbox. **Snow Plowing /Salting of Roads-**When snow begins to fall, residents having access to their yard from an alleyway must park their vehicles there. If a driveway does not exist, all residents must move vehicles to the even-numbered (house numbers) side of the street. When the odd-numbered side of the street has been cleared of snow/ice, residents must move vehicles to the odd-numbered side of the street. **Please use ice melt on sidewalks instead of salt. If you are out of Town for an extended period of time during the winter months, you must make arrangements for your sidewalks to be shoveled in your absence.**

Voter Qualifications

- United States Citizen and Resident of the Town of Bridgeville
- Resided within the corporate limits of the Town at least thirty (30) days prior to the Town Election.
- At least eighteen (18) years of age
- Registered Voter at Town Hall by February 20th, 2018 at 4:30 pm
- Registered Voter in the State of Delaware
- Voter Registration is available at Bridgeville Town Hall, 101 N. Main St. Monday-Friday, 8:30 AM - 4:30 PM, until the February 20th deadline.
- The Town maintains five Voting Districts. Residents may only vote for the candidate in their District. Please contact Bridgeville Town Hall for Voting District information.
- This registration applies to Bridgeville Municipal Elections only and does not apply to Federal/State Elections.
