



**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE LANDSCAPING PLAN  
FOR THE BRIDGEVILLE SOUTH RPC DISTRICT AND MODIFYING  
THE DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS APPLICABLE TO SUCH PHASE**

**Resolution No. 2019-02**

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners of the Town of Bridgeville (“Commissioners”) established the Residential Planned Community (“RPC”) zoning district to provide the Town of Bridgeville with the flexibility to permit mixed-use developments, and to provide for the application of design ingenuity while protecting existing and future developments and achieving the goals of the Comprehensive Plan;

**WHEREAS**, the Town annexed approximately 833 acres land, zoned a majority of the annexed land RPC and approved a concept plan for the Bridgeville South RPC District on October 21, 2002;

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners approved a Revised RPC Concept Plan for the Bridgeville South RPC District on June 9, 2003;

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners approved the RPC Preliminary Site Plan for the Bridgeville South RPC District on July 14, 2003;

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners enacted Ordinance 2013-G to authorize the Commissioners to consider and approve modifications of the development standards generally applicable to RPC districts concurrent with approval of an RPC final development plan for a particular phase or phase(s) of development;

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners of Bridgeville approved amendments to the RPC Preliminary Plan for Phase Three of the Bridgeville South RPC District on November 11, 2013;

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners of Bridgeville approved the preliminary site development plan and subdivision plat for Phase Three of Heritage Shores on March 10, 2014;

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners of Bridgeville approved the RPC final plan, subdivision plats development and landscape plans for Phase 3A of Heritage Shores and modified certain development standards applicable thereto by Resolution R14-2 on May 12, 2014; an

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners of Bridgeville approved the RPC final plan, subdivision plats development and landscape plans for Phase 3B of Heritage Shores and modified certain development standards applicable thereto by Resolution R14-6 on August 11, 2014;

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners of Bridgeville approved the RPC final plan, subdivision plats development and landscape plans for Phase 4A Revised of Heritage Shores and modified certain development standards applicable thereto by Resolution R 2017-10 on December 11, 2017;

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners of Bridgeville approved the RPC final plan, subdivision plats development and landscape plans for Phase 4B Revised of Heritage Shores and modified certain development standards applicable thereto by Resolution R 2018-03 on June 11, 2018;

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners of Bridgeville approved the RPC final plan, subdivision plats development and landscape plans for Phase 4C Revised of Heritage Shores and modified certain development standards applicable thereto by Resolution R 2018-07 on October 8, 2018; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners of the Town of Bridgeville are of the opinion that this resolution promotes the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Town of Bridgeville.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF BRIDGEVILLE HEREBY RESOLVE:**

Section 1: Approval of Revised Landscaping Plans. Heritage Shores. The following landscaping plan is hereby approved for the Phase 4C portion of the Bridgeville South RPC District located within the RPC District as depicted by the plans attached hereto as **Exhibit “A”** (the “Approved Plans”):

- a. “HERITAGE SHORES Screening Berm at Rear of Lots Along Commercial Parcel”, dated December 20, 2017.

The foregoing and any other deviations from the generally applicable development standards shall be specifically identified and approved by the Commissioners during review of the RPC final development plan.


Section 2. Effective Date:
