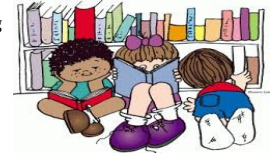

Adult Craft Night-Thursday, July 25th from 6-8pm. Registration is required. Call the library 337-7401 before July 23rd.

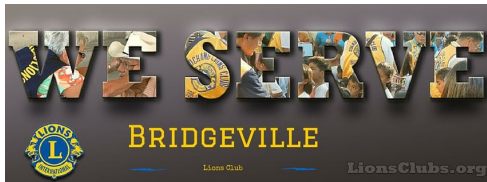
