In addition, Mr. Savage represented the Town at many important meetings and at various functions throughout the county and state. We are proud that he was able to represent Bridgeville on the Delaware League of Local Government's Legislative Advocacy Committee. His leadership and abilities earned him the honor of being named the Delaware League of Local Government's 2017 Town Manager of the Year.

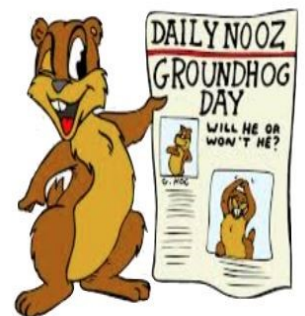

Voter Qualifications

- United States Citizen and Resident of the Town of Bridgeville
- Resided within the corporate limits of the Town at least thirty (30) days prior to the Town Election.
- At least eighteen (18) years of age
- Registered Voter at Town Hall by February 26th, 2018 at 4:30 pm
- Registered Voter in the State of Delaware
- Voter Registration is available at Bridgeville Town Hall, 101 N. Main St. Monday-Friday, 8:30 AM - 4:30 PM, until the February 20th deadline.
- The Town maintains five Voting Districts. Residents may only vote for the candidate in their District. Please contact Bridgeville Town Hall for Voting District information.
- This registration applies to Bridgeville Municipal Elections only and does not apply to Federal/State Elections.
