



BRIDGEVILLE TOWN HALL ACCESS WILL BE LIMITED.

Pursuant to guidance from the State of Delaware to protect the public and municipal employees from COVID-19 exposure, access to Bridgeville Town Hall will be limited to the general public until further notice. The main entrance will be open; however, access to the rest of the building will be closed. The window to the main office will be closed to avoid direct contact. Town Hall will currently not be taking cash payments, but residents may still drop off other forms of payment. Bridgeville residents may pay their Water & Sewer bills, Tax Bills or invoices by placing payments in the lock box by the side door. Residents may also pay via U.S. mail, the Town's website, or they may pay by phone by calling PSN, 1-877-885-7968.

We do not take payments over the phone here at Town Hall. At this time, we will not offer notary, fax, or copy services. The Commissioners of Bridgeville will determine when the building will fully reopen to the public. Town Hall will be closing at 4 p.m. to the general public until further notice.

The Bridgeville Police Department will continue to respond to calls. The Police Department can be reached at 302-337-8302. In the event of an emergency, call 9-1-1.

Town Hall staff and Public Works will continue to work while office access remains limited. Town staff will still be available by telephone by calling (302) 337-7135. In-person meetings with Town staff may be arranged by appointment.
