## Court of Appeals

The Commissioners of Bridgeville have rescheduled the Court of Appeals tentatively for Saturday, May 23rd from 1:00 pm to 2:00 pm at Town Hall, 101 N. Main Street, Bridgeville, Delaware. At that time, Town staff will hear requests for appeals and will be available to answer questions dealing with the 2020 Property Tax Assessments. A copy of the 2020 Property Tax Assessment listing is located at Town Hall for public view during normal business hours. It is also available on the Town's website, [www.bridgeville.delaware.gov](http://www.bridgeville.delaware.gov). **Please note that this date may change depending on the State of Emergency.**

**Just a reminder, Town Hall is currently closed to the general public, however, administrative staff are available by email and phone to address questions from the public, residents and contractors.**
