#### Annette Cottrell

18 Harlequin Loop- Mrs. Cottrell asked about meter reading for bills and when it goes beyond 30 days her bill goes in a different bracket with the wastewater so that makes her bill higher. President Carey stated that he would like the Water Department know her complaint regarding timely water readings. Mrs. Cottrell asked if the Town Manager position has been filled as of yet. President Carey stated that it has not but they are looking for someone to fill the position.

### **Charles Cephas**

39 Church Street-Mr. Cephas stated that he does not think it is fair that if someone parks on the grass the violation goes to the home owner. President Carey stated that he would need to speak with Chief Parker regarding code enforcement.

## New Business-Ordinance to Amend the Bridgeville Code to Provide for the Appointment and Removal of a Town Manager

Solicitor Schrader stated that about 8 or 9 years ago they Commission needed a Charter amendment adopted in order to authorize the Commissioners to appoint or fire a Town Manager, then they filled the position with Jesse Savage who already worked for the town so they did not do the Ordinance that needed to be adopted. Solicitor Schrader stated that this Ordinance that allows the Commissioners by majority vote of the members that are elected to the Commission to appoint or remove a Town Manager and sets the duties of the Town Manager. Solicitor Schrader described the duties to the Commission.
