In order to vote in Municipal Elections you must be registered to vote at Town Hall.


Districts 4 & 5 will be up for election in 2021.

You will need to fill out an Application, the fee is \$25 per bedroom and have an inspection done by the Chief of Police.



Any person or company who does business in Bridgeville must obtain a Business license with the Town Per Chapter 110 of the Code. This includes Solicitors as well. If your business is based within Town limits, you will need to fill out the application but you do not have to pay the fee.
