COVID-19 Related Updates – Town Hall Hours

We began phased reopening Town Hall to the general public on May 10, 2021. Monday Through Friday, 9 am to 2 pm ONLY. Please note that these hours may change to protect the health and safety of our staff in light of the recently increased spread of the COVID-19 Delta variant.

Appointments can still be made on an as-needed basis from **9:00 to 4:00**. Please take precautions when coming into Town Hall. If you feel sick or have any COVID-related symptoms, we ask that you stay at home and continue using the dropbox, online, and phone payment options. Upcoming Election

To vote in Municipal Elections, you must be registered at Town Hall at least 10 days prior to an election. Please note that this is a separate registration from the state's electoral registration process.

Districts 1, 2 & 3 are up for election on March 5, 2022.

Redistricting

With each decennial census, the Town must redraw its district lines. In January, town staff will be working with the University of Delaware's Center for Applied Demography and Survey Research to analyze the 2020 Census Data. A series of public hearings will follow before districts are adopted, currently estimated for completion Summer of 2022.
