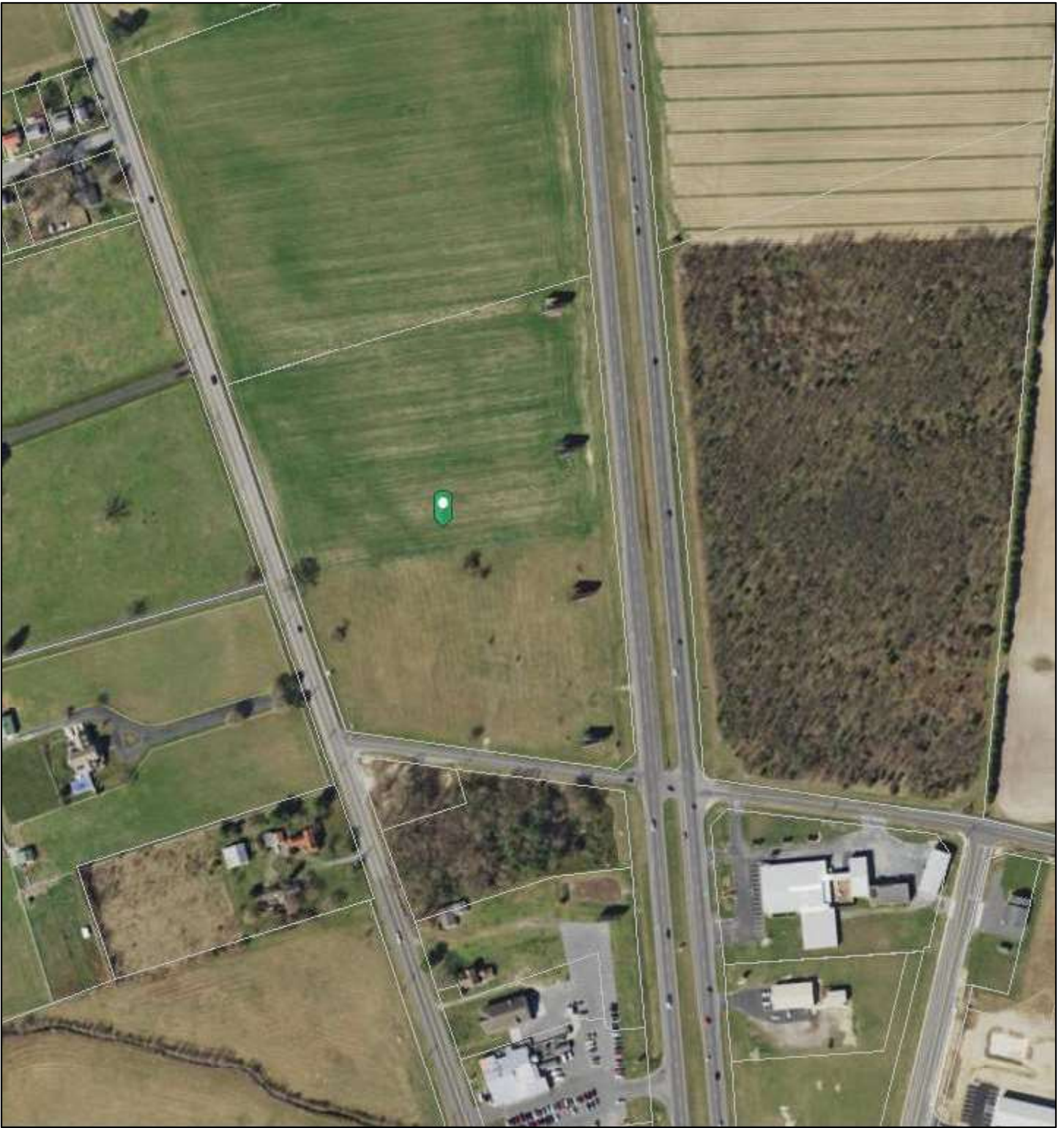
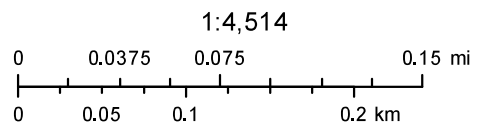


# 7.0 - AQUIFER RECHARGE AREAS

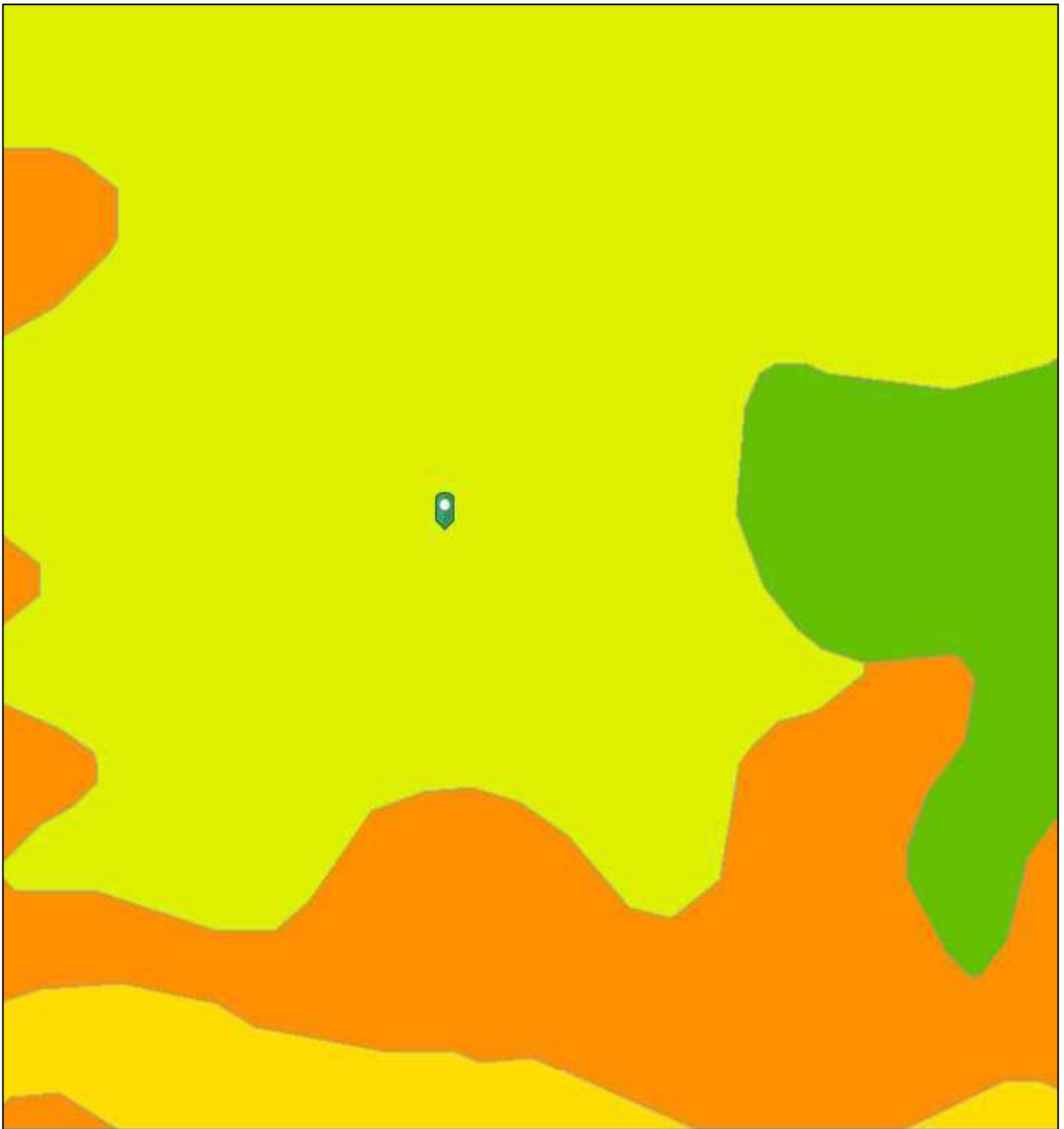

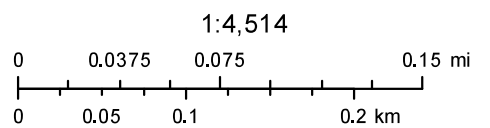
# 9.0 - STATE WETLAND MAPPING PROJECT



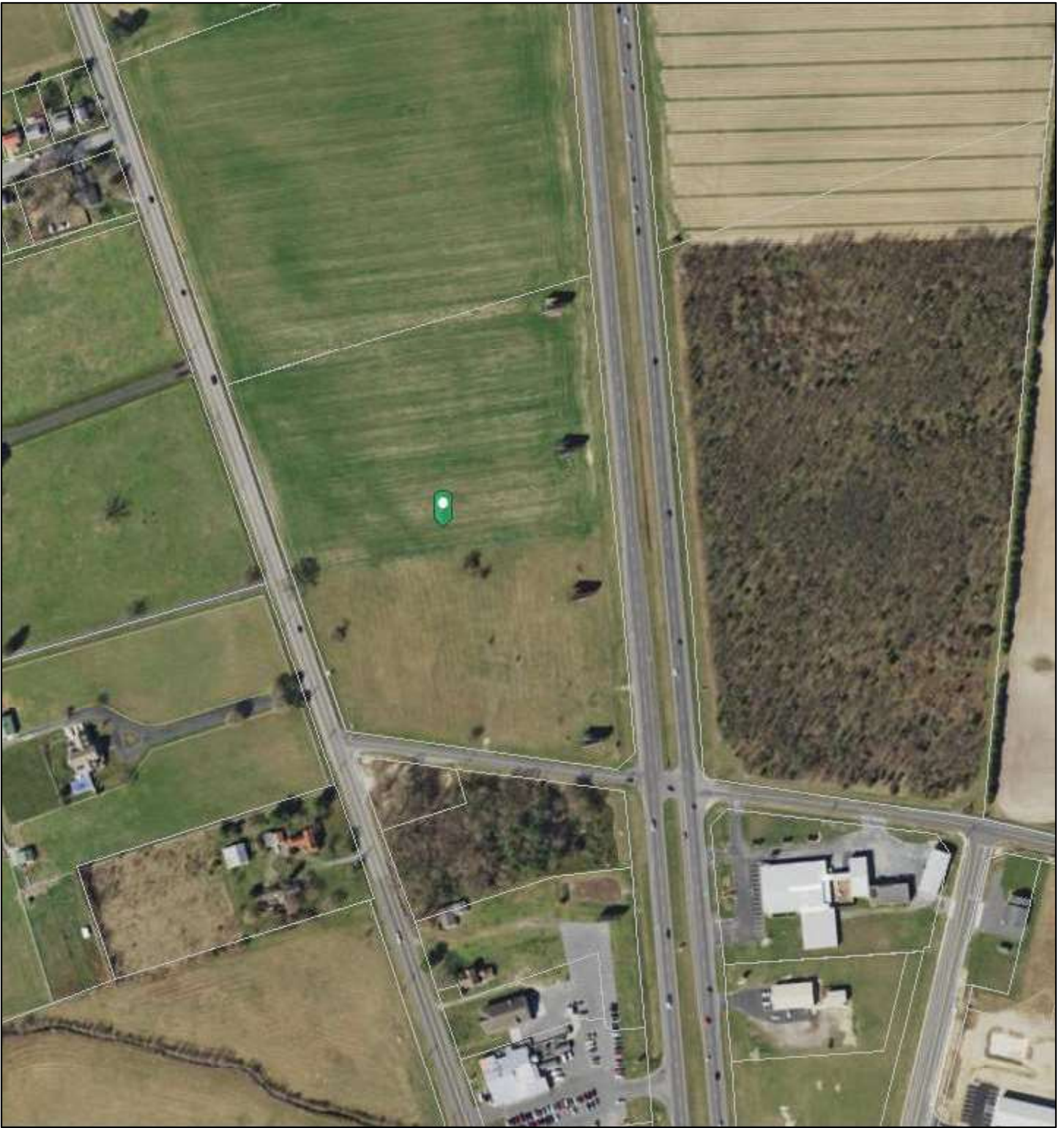

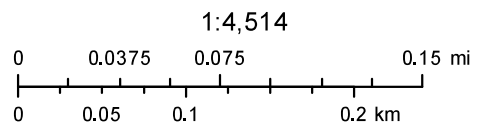


# 10.0 - HEAD OF TIDE MAPPING

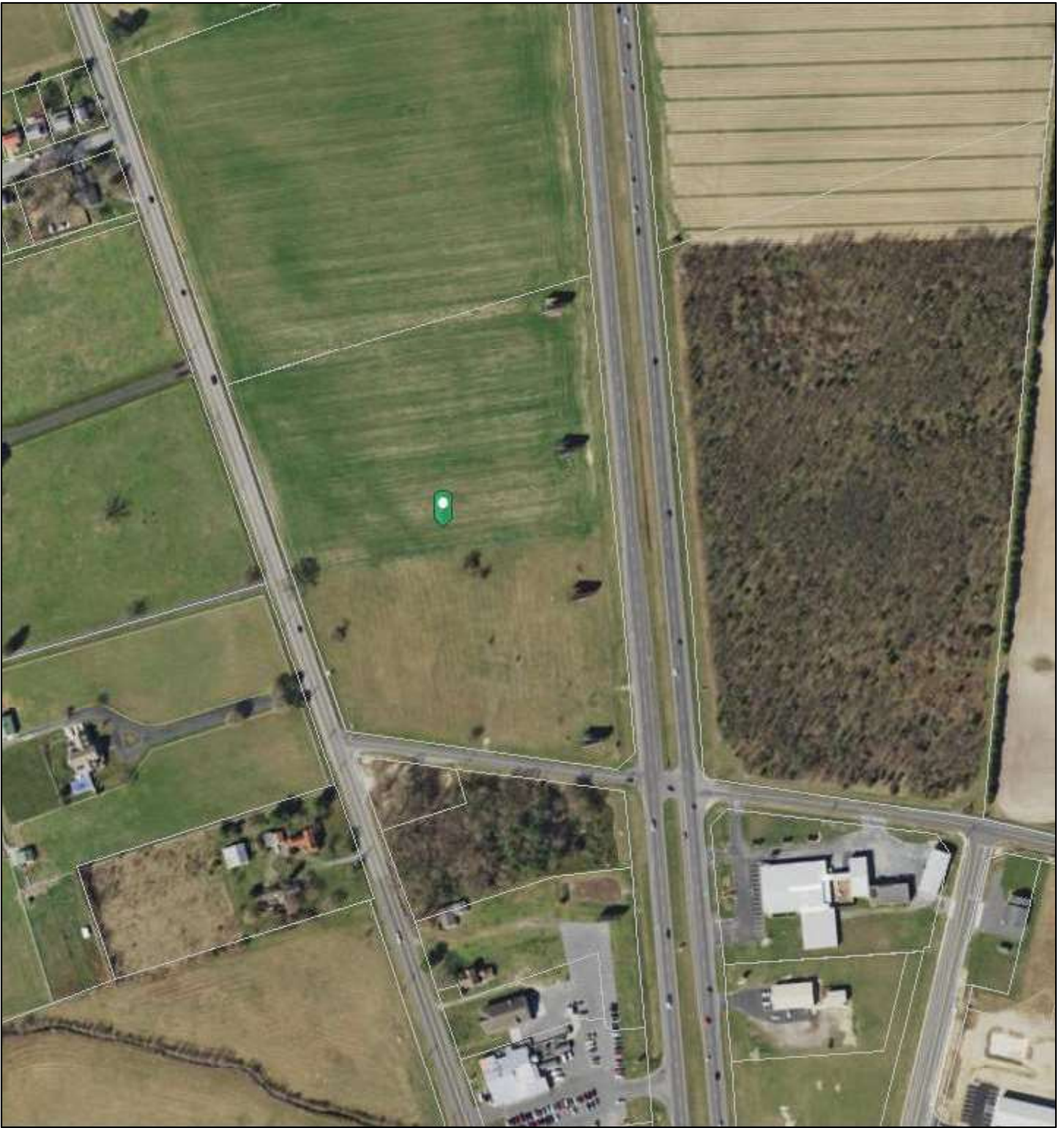

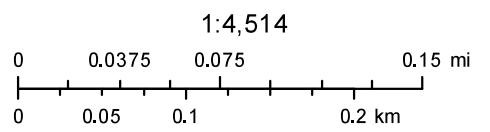


# 11.1 - SIRB SITE

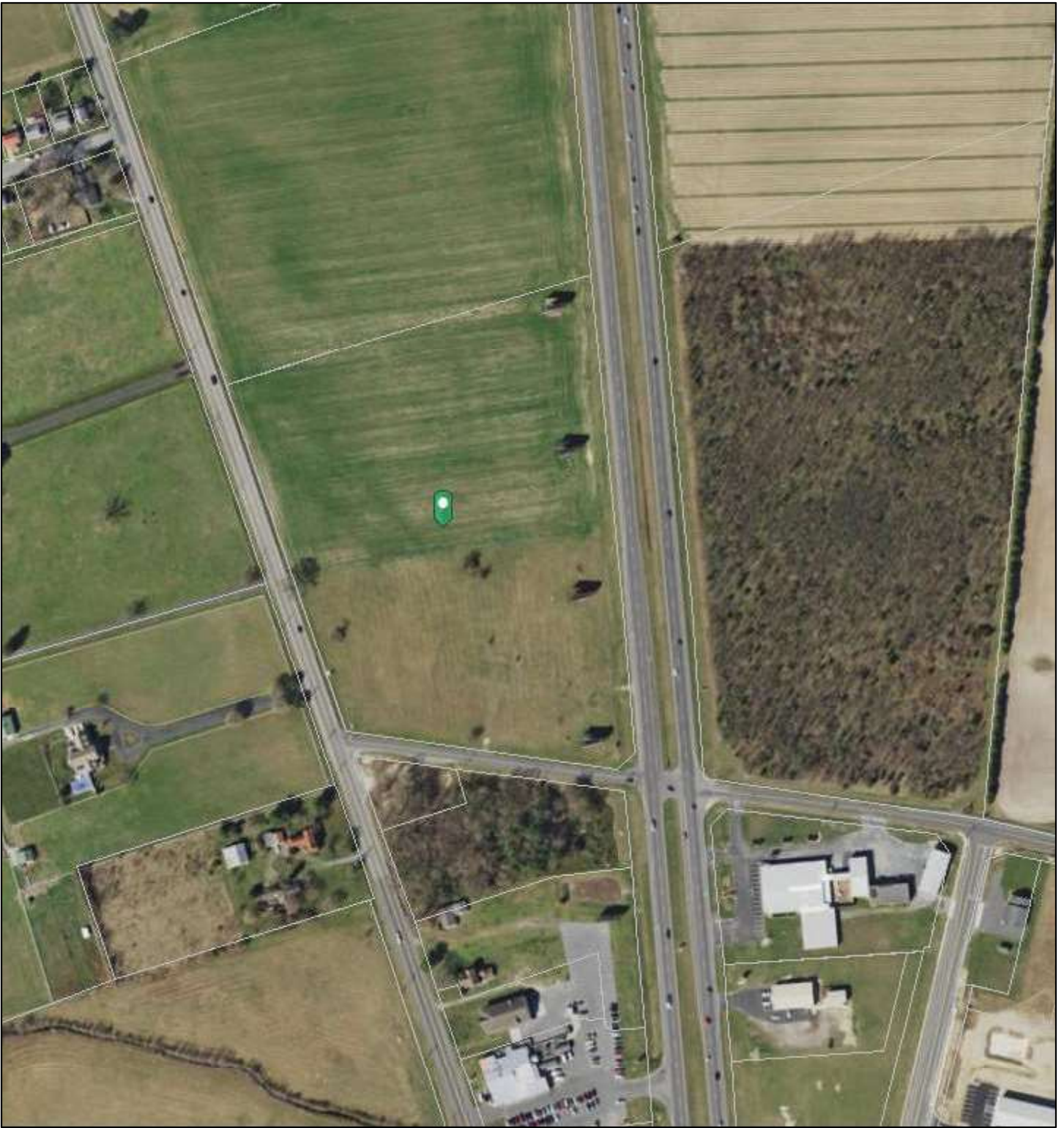

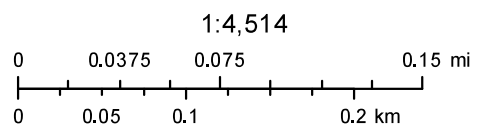


# 11.2 - LEAKING TANKS

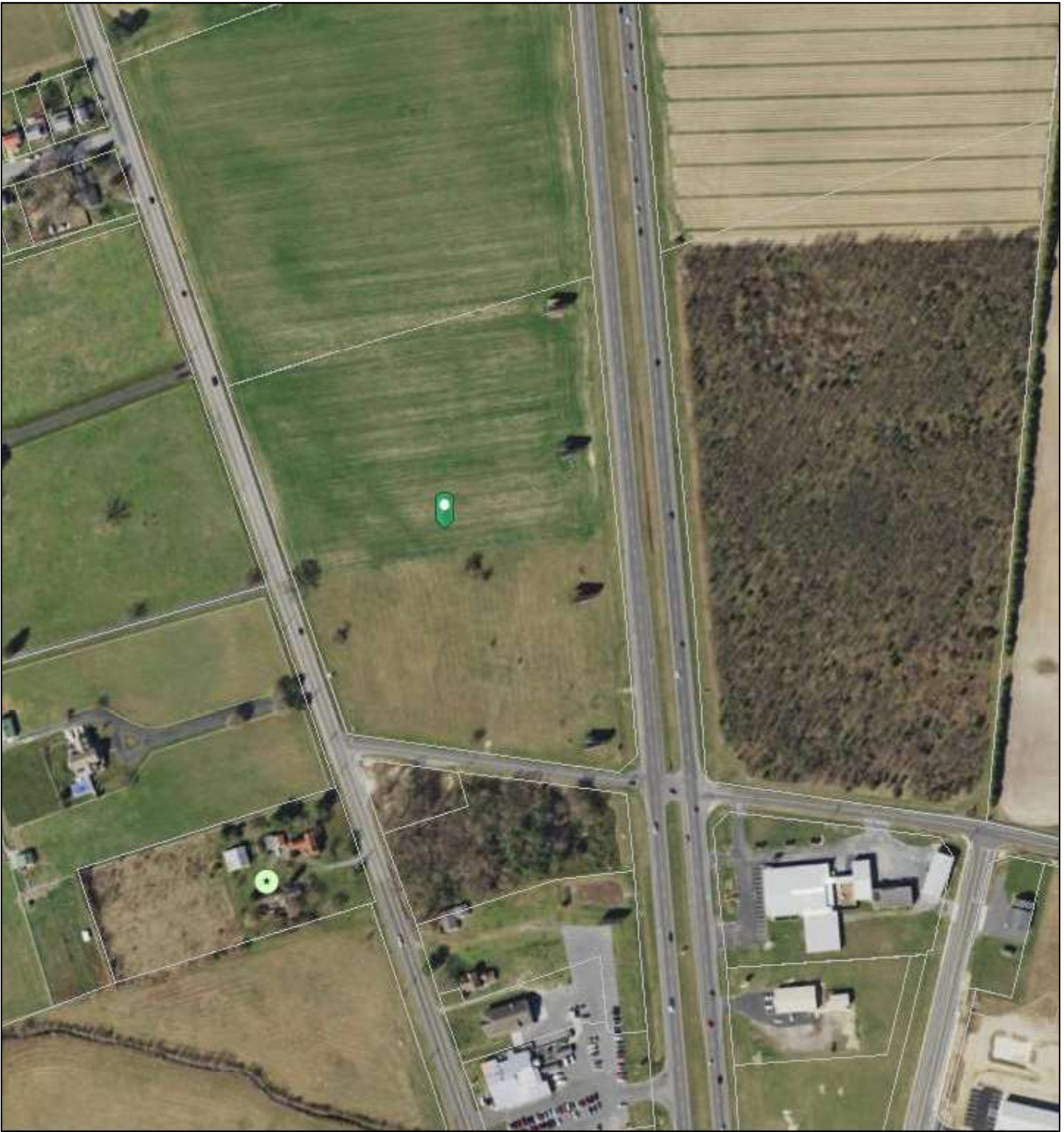

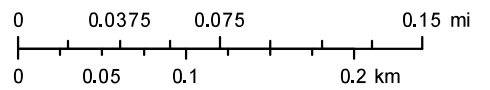




# 11.3 - ABOVE GROUND STORAGE TANKS



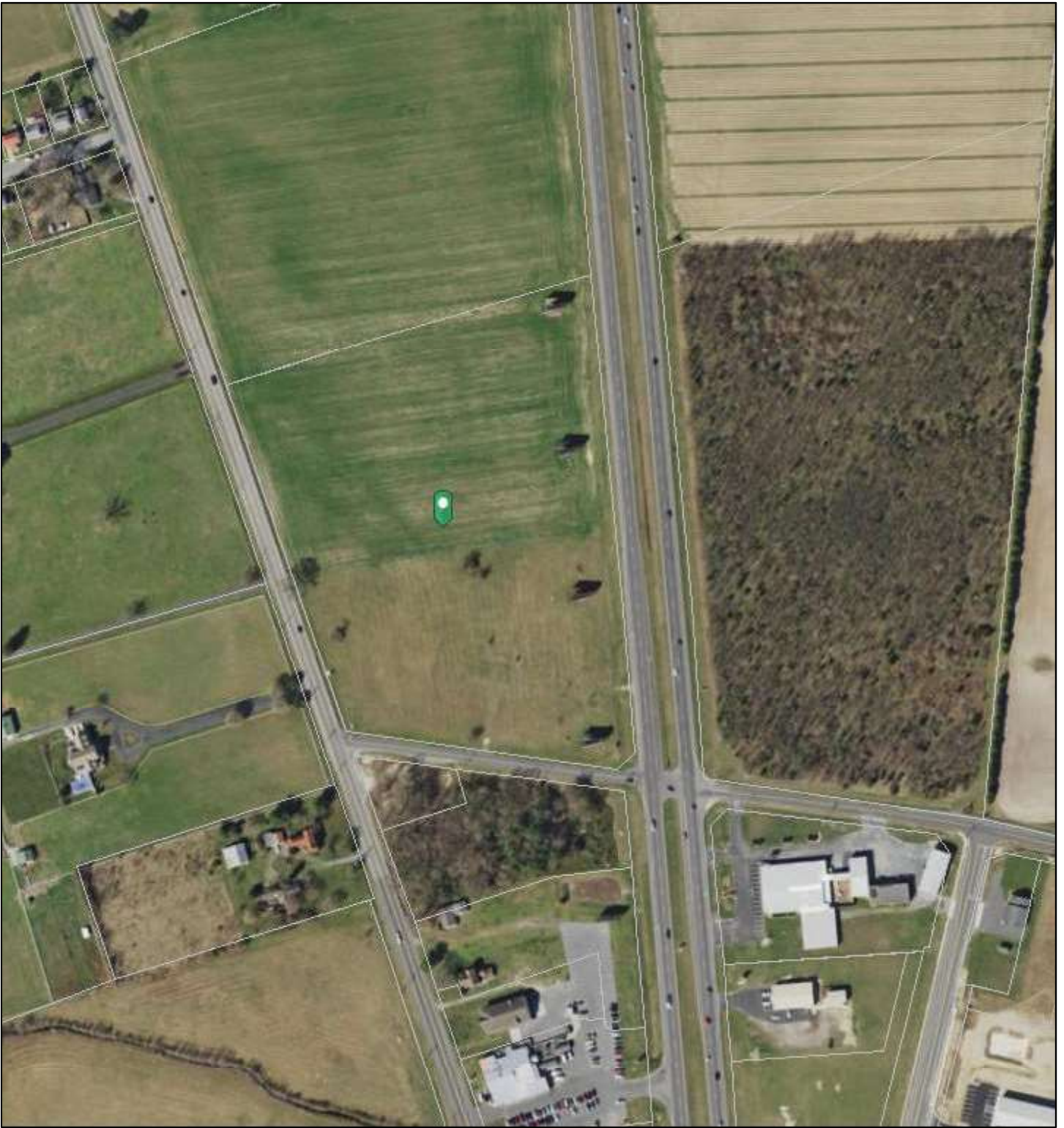

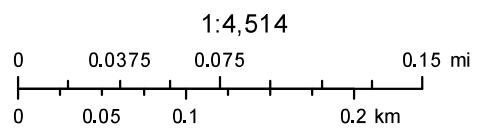


# 11.5 - SOLID AND HAZARDOUS WASTE SITE
