Dear Mr. Shearon:

Your commercial entrance plan dated September 30, 2004, was approved by the Department of Transportation on October 5, 2004, as shown on the enclosed plans and as noted. As per the approved entrance plan, this site will not be permitted to discharge any stormwater runoff into the existing State Highway drainage system.

Note:

The South District Permit Supervisor will not issue an entrance permit until the Department is in receipt of a copy of the recorded Record Plan showing all appropriate signatures, seals and Plot Book and Page.

This letter does not authorize the commencement of entrance construction. You must obtain a permit for entrance construction from DeIDOT prior to beginning work. Please take this plan and your itemized cost estimate to the District Permit Supervisor, so he may issue the required entrance permit. This plan approval shall be valid a period of six (6) weeks. If an extension of time is needed, contact the Permit Supervisor in writing before the six (6) week period has expired. Otherwise, the plan must be resubmitted for review.

A 150% bond based upon the itemized construction cost estimate will be required at the time an entrance permit has been requested. Please contact the Permit Supervisor (853-1342) directly concerning any questions you may have relative to the bonding procedure and permit.
