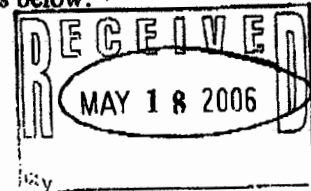
SUBJECT: Renewal of Coverage Under the NPDES Permit

You currently have General NPDES Storm Water Permit coverage for the project named on the attached report based upon your submittal of a Notice of Intent (NOI) for Storm Water Discharges Associated with Construction Activity to our office. However, the permit under which the NOI gained your project Permit coverage has expired at the Federal level. The Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control has adopted revised *Regulations Governing Storm Water Discharges Associated with Industrial Activities (The General NPDES Permit Program)*, including *Part 2 Special Conditions for Storm Water Discharges Associated with Construction Activities*. The regulations were published in the State's February Register of Regulations, and became effective February 11, 2006.

In order to continue to receive Federal permit coverage for your project, you must register for coverage under the revised program by submitting an updated NOI Form (enclosed). Projects required to obtain coverage under this Program will be held accountable for complying with all requirements outlined in the recently revised *Part 2 Special Conditions for Storm Water Discharges Associated with Construction Activities*.

The revised Notice of Intent (NOI) form must be submitted **within 90 days**. Make any edits to the attached form and sign the Certification statement and return the form to the address below:
