Water Rate Increase – Effective with October Water Bills

In August, after a six-month-long rate study, a water rate increase was approved by the Commission. This increase will help cover the costs of our water system and contribute towards future repairs, expansion, upgrades, and improvements.

A rate increase for water has not been adopted since 2010 – and we were able to cover costs for the system in that time with surplus from the wastewater system. Now, without that system, we are taking steps to make our Water Department self-sufficient, financially sound, able to meet the needs of our community, and able to maintain safe and healthy levels of water quality.

Monthly Water Service Fee:

¾" Meter (Standard Residential)	\$15.00 [from \$7.50] per month
¾" Meter - Secondary (Irrigation, Etc.)	\$10.00 [from \$5.50] per month

(The below sizes are generally Commercial/Industrial)

1" Meter	\$18.75 per month
2" Meter	\$33.75 per month
3" Meter	\$48.75 per month
4" Meter	\$63.75 per month

Water Usage Fee:

0-5,000 gallons	\$3.76 [\$2.79] per thousand gallons per month
5,001-10,000 gallons	\$4.32 [\$3.35] per thousand gallons per month
Anything over 10,000 gallons	\$4.72 [\$3.75] per thousand gallons per month
