# Heritage Shores Special Tax District Annual Meeting with Municap


We are trying to get back on schedule with the annual Heritage Shores Special Tax District Meeting with Municap. Typically, we try to have these meetings in advance of each year's property tax bills coming out, but we were thrown off schedule during COVID.

This year's meeting will be on June 12, 2023, at 4:30 PM at the Bridgeville Public Library, 600 S. Cannon Street. Representatives from Municap will be available to make a presentation and answer questions related to the Heritage Shores Special Taxes.

We will also have the meeting available by Zoom, with the ability to ask questions by Zoom. A Zoom link has been provided on our website with options to join online or call in by phone. The meeting will also be recorded for the ability to watch at a later date.

Please be aware that the meeting room at the library has a max capacity of 150 people, so it will be on a first-come, first-served basis for in-person attendance.
