The contract should be approved by the County Council on July 20<sup>th</sup> and commence in mid-August. The completed plan is to be submitted to the County Council in mid-November. The contract provides for an orientation meeting with all stakeholders, including Bridgeville next month. Mr. Levy will keep the Commission updated as the county moves forward to update its plan.
