ORDINANCE NO. A12-1

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 84 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF BRIDGEVILLE RELATING TO EXEMPTIONS FROM THE DANGEROUS DOG ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Town of Bridgeville are desirous of acknowledging that not all dogs defined as dangerous in Bridgeville Code are in fact dangerous simply by reason of breed.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COMMISSIONERS OF BRIDGEVILLE HEREBY ORDAIN:

Section 1. Amend Chapter 84 "ANIMALS," Article II Dogs, Section 84-10. Definitions, dangerous dogs, by adding the **underlined** text as follows:

P. Upon proper consideration of any training certificates, community service awards, or similar certifications, the Board of Animal Control may make a recommendation to the Commissioners of the Town of Bridgeville to waive the registration fee for any dog that has been automatically deemed a dangerous dog by breed. Once the recommendation has been forwarded to the Commissioners, they shall vote on the matter. A simple majority vote shall determine whether or not the fee shall be waived.

COMMISSIONERS OF BRIDGEVILLE

Section 2. Effective Date. The ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption by a majority of the members elected to the Commission.
