Good afternoon. Sorry I did not receive this message as I would have immediately responded. The information below explains how funds are utilized to assist with the needs of the community. I had indicated how funds are utilized in the original letter, stating that all assistance is related to the needs in the community, such as assistance with utility payments to avoid disconnections, rentall/shelter assistance to avoid evictions, heating /fuel assistance during the winter months, and occasionally medications, and school supplies. Also homelessness needs when shelters are filled to capacity during the winter months with hotel stay for families with small children. We assist on many occasions when requested with helping families through the Division of State Service Centers here in Bridgeville when their funds are limited or inadequate to meet an individual's needs. We are also called on to assist some Bridgeville families with needs by First State Community Action Agency due to limited funding or eligibility requirements as well. Annually, we identify and sponsor two families during the Christmas holiday season. Under no circumstances are the outreach contributions or funds utilized for anything church related. The program was established to assist with the needs of the disadvantaged, disenfranchised families in the community, not for the sustainment of the church. I hope this explains the relationship between the church and the outreach program. Thank you for your help as it is greatly apprecated.
