Property Tax bills will be mailed out to all property owners around the middle of July. Please remember that property tax statements are for the fiscal year beginning 7/1/2023 through 6/30/2024, which will be the date shown on your statement - and payment is due NO LATER than September 30, 2023. Interest will automatically accrue on October 2, 2023, and every month after that. This is year 5 of the approved 5-year tax increase. The FY24 tax rate is \$3.00 per hundred dollars of 50% of the County assessment.

The re-assessment process has not yet been completed and is now projected to be finalized in 2025. Details on that project can be found at https://sussexcountyde.gov/assessment.

If you live in Heritage Shores and have not prepaid your Special Tax District taxes, your property tax bill will have a separate line item for those taxes. The Town will process the payment and pass it on to the bond management agency, Municap. Should you have any guestions regarding your Special Tax District assessment, you may contact Municap directly at (443) 539-4104 or www.municap.com.

For all taxes, you can view or pay your tax bill through our iGovServices tax payment portal – by going to our website, under the "Pay Online" tab, and clicking "Tax Payments." The direct link is https://bridgevillede.igovservices.com/User/Login. You can choose to create an account or simply use the search tab, which brings you to our public record portal, and view or pay directly there.
