New Car Seat Laws

Effective on June 30, 2024, Delaware's Child Restraint Law requires:

- Children under age 2 AND 30 pounds to ride in a rear-facing car seat.
- Children under age 4 AND 40 pounds to ride in a harnessed car seat.
- Children in booster seats are to remain in their booster seat until reaching the height or weight maximum listed by the manufacturer (There is no booster seat with a height maximum lower than 4'4").

We check all types of seats- rear-facing, forward-facing, harnessed, and boosters. It is FREE to the public, and only takes about 20 minutes. Contact Shelley at the Police Station to get yours checked!

Harvest Season

Harvest season is a busy time for agriculture. Be patient when approaching farm equipment on the road and only pass when it's safe – Equipment operators cannot always safely pull to the side of the road to let you pass by. Also, a reminder that agricultural operations are exempt from hourly workday restrictions and noise ordinances – especially if a storm is predicted – farmers may work through the nights and for days in a row to save their crops.
