#### Travel Tips

1. Stop all deliveries or have a trusted person pick them up.
2. Do not discuss your absence casually.
3. Keep a list of valuables.  
(make/model/color/serial number/etc.)
4. Do not close all drapes/blinds.
5. Move valuables away from view of windows.
6. Put outdoor property away.  
(bicycles/lawn furniture/etc)
7. Leave a key with a trusted individual who can contact you in case of an emergency and can respond to your home if the Police Department requests them to.
