Commissioners discussed awarding the contract for the new storm drains and catch basins on N. Cannon behind Market Street. Town Engineers- Davis, Bowen, and

Friedel, recommended Hopkins Construction from the recently closed bid process. Bond bill funds will be used to cover this project.

A motion was made to award the contract to Hopkins Construction by Commissioner Carey; seconded by Commissioner Carey. Motion carried: 4 Yes votes, 0 No votes.

Grant-In-Aid/Donations

Commissioner Oliver would like to donate \$100, Commissioner Carey would like to donate \$200, and Commissioner Tomeski would like to donate \$200 to the Library's Summer Reading Program. Commissioner Carey would also like to donate \$100 to the Heritage Shores Military Club.

A motion was made to donate \$500 to the Bridgeville Public Library's Summer Reading Program, and \$100 to the Heritage Shores Military Club by Commissioner Carey and seconded by Commissioner Harris. Motion carried: 4 Yes votes, 0 No votes.
