CODE AND FEE REVIEWS-CONTINUED

Town Manager DeBussy discussed the guidance received from the town solicitor regarding adopting the International Building Code. Commissioners decided his opinion be put in writing and discussed more before adopting as there may be legality issues.

OPEN DISCUSSION

AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN FUNDING

Town Manager DeBussy reviewed possibilities for the remaining funds. There are old lead/copper water lines that need to be replaced, the expected amount is 11 streets- \$4.1 million. The suggestion is to start working on that list of replacements with the remaining ARPA funds. Commissioners requested the vote be on the agenda for the November Commission meeting.

GOOD OF THE ORDER:

Commissioner Harris attended the Ryan Homes ribbon cutting in Heritage Shores. He suggested the Town recognize other holidays/religions during the Christmas season.

Commissioner Oliver requested organizations be more aware of their prayers during public meetings/events. Oliver also requested a synopsis of the Planning and Zoning meeting that was held in October; Town Manager DeBussy stated the crowd was there for a public hearing setting and became angry when that was not on the agenda for that meeting. Commissioner Moran states the residents discussed the meeting with him and he suggested they attend a meeting.

Commissioner Tomeski wished the Town luck during the Trunk or Treat event.

Town Manager DeBussy gave details about the upcoming Heritage Shores Military Club Concert.


EXECUTIVE SESSION

Commissioners entered executive session at 5:32PM, and exited at 6:00PM.


ADJOURNMENT:
