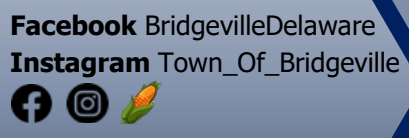
Help a family in your community this holiday season!

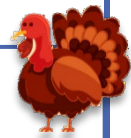
Business and Rental Licenses

All Business and Rental Property Licenses expire at the end of the calendar year (December 31, 2025). Applications are available online and at Town Hall.

Renewals also require new/updated forms to be submitted.

For Rental Property Licenses, rental inspections may only be scheduled with First State Inspection Agency once the application forms and payment are received at Town Hall. All rental property inspections should be scheduled with First State Inspection Agency no later than **February 28, 2026.**

Building Permits



Reminder that by Town Code, it shall be unlawful for any person, partnership, business or corporation to undertake or cause to be undertaken the construction, reconstruction, enlargement, alteration or relocation of any building or structure unless an approved building permit has been obtained. For properties within Heritage Shores, permit applications must also have HOA approval. However, HOA approval is not the only approval needed. Please be sure to contact Town Hall for your projects to ensure compliance with Town Codes and avoid potential fines.
