CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Williams

Commissioner Williams reported that a quorum was present.

18116 Sussex Highway, Bridgeville Laundry & CAr Wash & Mini Storage, LLC submitted by Robert Purnell

Representative for the project, John Pardee, submitted a request for a variance from the required 15-foot landscape buffer between residential and nonresidential districts located in C-1 Commercial at Tax Map 131-10.00-83.00. Robert Parnell states the cost to change the plan for the property would be over \$100,000- the pond and buildings would need to be moved if the variance is not approved. Mr. Parnell would like to have a solid fence or 5-10 feet tall hedge around the property boundary.

Notice of Public Hearing was posted in accordance with the Town Charter. Public Hearing was open at 3:44pm. Kristina Conners, 6 Elm Street (in person and via email); Shelley Boyd, 2 Elm Street; Patricia Correll, 421 S. Main Street, Donna Eddy, 101 Jacobs Ave; Beth Murrow, 502 S. Main Street; and Melanie Robb, all expressed their concerns over the "eye sore" the project has been over the years and does not agree the variance request should be approved. Public Hearing Closed at 3:46pm.

A recommendation was made to approve the variance request for a six foot solid fence and shrub buffer not less than 5 feet by Commissioner Williams; seconded by Commissioner Castelli. Motion carried: 4 Yes votes, 0 No votes.
