- Registered Voter in Municipality at least one year prior to the date of the Election.
- Candidate must not have ever been convicted of a Felony.
- Must live within the Election Voting District you wish to represent.
- File a written letter of intent to be a candidate with the Commission President or Secretary by February 6, 2026.
