Motion made, seconded and carried that an addition #9 be made to ordinance #17: ~~#14~~ Parking and Blocking Violation to wit;

- a. Except as otherwise provided in this section, every vehicle stopped or parked upon a two-way roadway shall be so stopped or parked with the right hand wheels parallel to and within 12 inches of the right hand curb or edge of the roadway.
- b. Except where otherwise provided by local ordinance, every vehicle stopped or parked upon a one-way roadway shall be so stopped or parked parallel to the curb, or edge of the roadway in the direction of authorized traffic movement, with its right hand wheels within 12 inches of the right hand curb or edge of the roadway, or its left wheels within 12 inches of the left hand curb or edge of the roadway.
- c. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this sections shall be fined \$1.00.

Mr. Simons nominated Mr. Culver as President of Town Commissioners, nomination seconded by Mr. Willey. Nominations were moved closed, Mr. Culver was elected by unanimous vote of the Commissioners.

Mr. Willey moved that Donald L. Melson be nominated Secretary, seconded by Mr. Simons. Nominations were moved closed. Mr. Melson elected Secretary.

Minutes of the last regular and special meetings were read and approved.

It was regularly moved, seconded and carried that Mr. A. Dean Betts be appointed Attorney for the town for the year 1965.

Regularly moved, seconded, and carried that Mrs. Hattie Sylvia be appointed Town Alderman for 1965.

Mrs. Mildred Brown was nominated for Treasurer, nomination was seconded and moved closed. Mrs. Brown was elected.

Moved, Seconded, and carried that the town accept the assessment figures of the County-these figures to be used as the assessment for the town for the year 1965-1966, and that the Treasurer be authorized to pick up these figures from the county records.

It was regularly moved, seconded, and carried that Frank Galante be appointed Police Chief, Al Sharon as police office, David Dimes as police Officer ~~all~~ ⁱⁿ all on a thirty day basis pending a review of rules and regulations ~~that~~ governing control of police force.

Fines received from Mrs. Sylvia were \$547.00.

Invoices totaling \$1831.25 were presented for payment. It was moved, seconded, and carried that all bills be paid per the attached list; and that the following bills from the above mentioned total be paid from the municipal street aid fund
