

Meeting No. 1 (Regular) held in Town Office on Mon. Feb. 13, 1956.

New members, John K. Simons, Earl C. Willey and James E. Culver sworn into office by Mrs. Pearl Thompson.

James Culver elected Temporary Chairman. Nominations were open for President with Earl Willey and James Culver being the nominees. James Culver elected by majority vote.

Robert Bennett and John Simons nominated for Secretary's position with Robert Bennett being elected by majority vote.

Nominations were opened for Town Treasurer. James Fairbanks was nominated by Daniel Short. Seconded by Earl Willey. Fairbanks being the only nominee he was automatically elected.

O. T. Warrington was nominated for Town Alderman by Robert Bennett. Seconded by Daniel Short and Mr. Warrington was elected for a term of one year.

Stanley Ledenham was appointed by the President as Auditor of the Town books. Secretary instructed to notify Mr. Ledenham, as soon as possible with the audit to be completed before the next regular meeting on March 12, 1956.

Daniel Short was also appointed as the Town's representative to the Bridgeville Branch Tax Ditch Committee.

Secretary instructed to write Daniel J. Layton, Jr. that he is again the Town Attorney.

Both Town Policemen, Carlos Passwaters and Irven Swain, were rehired for the coming year.

William Ralph Smith was chosen again as the Town plumber.

Minutes of meeting No. 26 read and approved.

A motion was made by Daniel Short that the Delaware Power & Light Co. make changes in the lighting system on Delaware Ave. and several other spots in Town for an additional \$10.00 per month. Copy of order on file in Treasurers office. Seconded by John Simons. Motion carried.

First reading given new ordinance concerning any Building within the Town Limits of Bridgeville which, because of its construction, age, material or want of proper and necessary repair shall constitute a menace to any adjoining building or which shall constitute a menace to the life and health of any of the residents of Bridgeville whether they be occupants of any such building or otherwise. Copy of ordinance on file in Town Treasurer's office.

Town Alderman's report read and approved. Total fines collected for January, 1956 were \$146.50 less costs of \$10.50 leaving a balance of \$136.00 which was turned over to Fairbanks for deposit.
