Fines turned in by Wm. P. Short Were \$ 85.00.

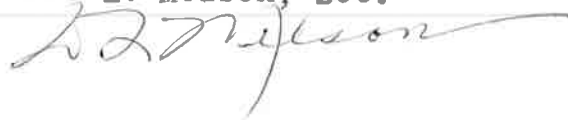
