Motion made by Wm. R. Reynolds to pay bills, seconded by T. J. Gray Jr.

There was a discussion in the present charges of Sewer and Water Taps. Since the cost has gone up on the installation of both of these, the board felt that it would be necessary to increase the fee of installation.

Wm. R. Reynolds made a motion that we increase the water and sewer taps to 75.00 each. Water from 50.00 at present and sewer from 60.00 at present. This was seconded by T. J. Gray, Jr.

Mr. Lynch talked to the board about making a cement catwalk at the disposal plant to help make it easier to scoop up grease, and for other work. Board decided to have O. A. Newton Co., to do this work for the price of 900.00 which was the amount they agreed to do it for.

Fines turned in for the month amounted to \$1492.50

Mr. Gray, said the Police Department had nothing new to report.

Mr. Reynolds discussed some patching and paving work that needed doing on the street.

Having received our final grant from the Government amounting to 38,723.00 it was decided to invest 39,000.00 in Baltimore Trust Company Bank Certificates for two year period, paying 5 3/4 per cent interest.

Being no further business meeting adjourned at 9. 30 P. M.
