

COMMISSIONERS OF BRIDGEVILLE
 REGULAR MEETING
 JUNE 8, 1970

Meeting called to order at 8 p. m. by President, Paul A. Lynch

Members present were Earl C. Willey, Wm. R. Reynolds, T. J. Gray, Jr. and Richard I. Lewis.

Dr. Beckert and Edwin James were also present to discuss the ordinance on burning trash, leaves, paper or anything within the town limits of Bridgeville. They were very much against this and felt that burning would destroy the germs, more than just letting things sit until the Garbage Collector picked it up, as most people just have a once a week delivery. As there had been many calls concerning this, it seemed that the public did not want it.

Mr. Lynch thanked the visitors for coming and expressing their views and told them that the board would discuss this more thoroughly and they would be notified of the board's decision.

Motion was made by Wm. R. Reynolds that the ordinance on burning be rescinded until we should hear from State Water and Air Resources Commission making this compulsory.

This was seconded by T. J. Gray, Jr.

Minutes of Last Regular and One Special Meeting was read and approved.

Mr. Lynch said that he and Orlan Brown had met with Dean Betts, town Solicitor in his office about an applicant who had filled a permit to build a store in a residential zone. They would be advised later if this man would want to meet with the Board of Adjustments.

He had also received a letter from Bridgeville Fire Company asking that the plugs be checked to give better use in case of fire. Mr. Lewis said he planned to have these things done.
