Gentlemen:

The committee for Fire hazzard and Health met with Mr. Walter Orendorf Friday August 6th., 1965 at 6:30 P.M. This meeting was arranged with Mr. Orendorf in order that the committee might go over with him the steps and repairs to be taken with regards to putting his property at 108 Main street in proper condition to conform with town ordinance covering.

Mr. Orendorf and the Committee agreed that the following list of items should be completed in order that this property be in conformance with said ordinance.

1. All debris be cleaned up completely and kept clean.
2. All grass and weeds be mowed and kept mowed.
3. That new siding be installed on entire house sidewalls, or that present siding be repaired and painted two coats.
4. All window glass that is now broken be replaced, missing sash replaced, and all exterior doors be fixed and kept locked.
5. That front porch be put in good condition with new concrete floor.
6. That roof on house be put in good condition.
7. That all chimneys be checked - pointed up and repaired where necessary.
8. That electrical wiring in building be modernized.
9. That interior of house to be put in good condition and suitable for renting.
10. That all of the above items be completed by Jan. 1, 1966.
11. That the Committee inspect the property at that time for conformance.
