

COMMISSIONERS OF BRIDGEVILLE
Regular Meeting
October 12, 1970

Meeting called to order by President Paul A. Lynch at 8:00 P.M.

Members present were Wm. R. Reynolds, T. J. Gray, Jr. and Richard I. Lewis.

Also present were Frankie Adams, Mike Layton, Jr., Robert Adams, Frankie Keel, George Jefferson and Kruger Hearne.

They were here to discuss the packing in the areas where they have business, as they felt they did not have enough parking room.

Mr. Lynch asked T. J. Gray, Jr. to read the State Code pertaining to this. He told the visitors the town had adopted these rules.

There was much discussion about the parking situation. Robert Adams asked the Board if they could not make a change in the present ruling about parking and to work with the merchants.

Frankie Adams made a complaint about Puerto Ricans hanging in front of his store and laundry, he requested that the police pick them up for loitering.

After this the men left and Mr. Lynch advised them that the Board would look further into this to see what could be done.

Wm. R. Reynolds made a motion to have diagonal parking at a 45 degree angle from Market St. to Mill St. on Cannon St. - starting back eight feet from Market Street and to have no parking on east side of Cannon St. in area discussed. Also have line marked in center of the road and proper parking markings. Seconded by T. J. Gray, Jr. and approved by the Board.

Motion made by Wm. R. Reynolds that there be parking at a 45 degree angle on Railroad Ave. - east side from Market St. to Delaware Ave. and parallel parking on west side of Railroad Ave. from Market St. to Delaware Ave. Seconded by T. J. Gray, Jr.

Motion made by Richard Lewis that there be a three way stop sign on corner of Edgewood and Cannon Sts. Also that there be two hour parking on west side of Laws St. to Walnut St. and Edgewood Sts. Seconded by Wm. R. Reynolds and approved by the Board.

Motion made by Wm. Reynolds that Paul A. Lynch be authorized to have streets marked for parking. Seconded by T. J. Gray, Jr.

Mr. Lynch had a request from the Diamond State Telephone Co. to run an underground cable at a 90 degree angle 9 feet from town property line to first telephone pole in order to install two telephones in back of town owned land. This request was approved by the Board.

Mr. Lynch had a partition signed by many residences on Market and Main Sts. asking that if possible, could the truck traffic be re-routed so it will not be as heavy on these streets. A copy of this had already been sent to the State Highway Department. Motion made by T. J. Gray, Jr. to contact the State Highway about such a change and to let them know the Town Board had approved of their idea. Seconded by Richard I. Lewis and approved by the board.
