

REGULAR MEETING
COMMISSIONERS OF BRIDGEVILLE
DECEMBER 11, 1967

Meeting called to order by President Culver at 8 P. M.

Other members present were T. J. Gray, Jr. G. F. Hardesty, Jr. and Earl C. Willey.

Also present was Mr. Jay Kleinhenn of 303 Walnut St. and Mr. George H. Torbert, Sr. Town Alderman.

Mr. Torbert presented \$235.00 for fines for the month of November.

Mr. Kleinhenn stated he didn't have anything to present to the Board for discussion. Mr. Kleinhenn stated. " I just want to sit and listen. I have rumors concerning the Police Department."

Mr. Culver announced for the Board to be present at the Town office on December 26 to open applications for Town Commissioners Election to be held on Jan. 2, 1968 at 1 P. M. to 6 P. M. at the town office.

The Board agreed and instructed Street Commissioner Earl C. Willey to approach the State Highway Department for them to consider replacing North and South Main Sts. complete with curbs and sidewalks at a total cost to the State.

President Culver reviewed the Budget thru 12/11/67. The Budget isn't sufficient at the present to pay the expenses. This was brought about partly because of \$5000.00 additional expense on water and sewer construction on Market Street.

It was moved and seconded to transfer enough funds as needed from the construction account to the general fund to take care of the expenses. The amount of the monies to be paid back to construction account and allowance provided for in the 1968-1969 Budget.

It was moved and seconded that the Board purchase the Culver property for \$6000.00 as appraised. The Secretary is hereby authorized to sign a sales agreement for the purchase of the above property. The terms are to be \$1000.00 down payment and the above balance paid by June 1, 1968 interest free.
