

Meeting No. 24 (Regular) held in the Town Office on Monday, December 12, 1955.

Meeting called to order at 8:10 PM by President James Culver with all members present.

Nelson Cannon present to see how the sewer project for Jacobs Drive and Elliotts Drive was progressing. He was told that before the Town could borrow money a bill would have to pass the State Legislature and then a referendum vote would have to be held by the people of Bridgeville, and that it would be almost two years before the State Legislature would again convene.

Town Aldermans report read and approved. Total of \$412.25 in fines collected for month of November.
