Ordinance referring to town dump was read second time as follows:

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of Bridgeville in regular monthly assembly that:

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or Corporation who are not tax payers of the Town of Bridgeville to enter upon the town dump located to the west of the Town of Bridgeville for the purpose of depositing therein any trash, garbage or refuse of any nature whatsoever, without first obtaining from the Commissioners of Bridgeville permission so to do.

Any person, firm or corporation convicted of a violation of this ordinance shall in addition to the costs of the proceeding, forfeit and pay a fine of not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00).
