Voter Qualifications

- U.S. Citizen and at least 18 years of age on or before the date of the Election.
- Must be a Bridgeville Resident for at least 30 days immediately preceding the date of Election.
- Registered Voter in the State of Delaware at least 30 days prior to the election.
- Must live within the same District as the candidate to vote for a candidate.
- Must provide identification to vote at the election.
- Political party affiliation does not impact municipal elections. The Commissioners of Bridgeville are a Non-Partisan government.

Voter Identification Requirements

- Proof of identity is required to vote. Per the State of Delaware, forms of identification may include:
 - Delaware Driver's License or State ID
 - U. S. Passport
 - Signed Polling Place or Social Security Card
 - Signed vehicle registration
 - Signed credit card with photo
 - A similar document that identifies the person by photo or signature

Absentee Ballots Will Be Available

February 17, 2026, through Noon on March 6, 2026. Registered voters who are unable to vote in person may request an absentee ballot. An application must be completed before an absentee ballot can be picked up or mailed. Absentee ballots must be received by the Election Board before the close of election polls at 7:00 pm on March 7, 2026.
