## **ORDINANCE No. A 11-6**

### **AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 17, ARTICLE II OF THE BRIDGEVILLE CODE RELATING TO THE DESCRIPTION OF ELECTION VOTING DISTRICTS WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE TOWN OF BRIDGEVILLE**

**WHEREAS**, the General Assembly of the State of Delaware enacted "AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 237, VOLUME 51, ENTITLED 'AN ACT TO REINCORPORATE THE TOWN OF BRIDGEVILLE' PERMITTING THE COMMISSIONERS OF BRIDGEVILLE BY ORDINANCE, TO ESTABLISH ELECTION DISTRICTS";

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners of Bridgeville initially established election districts by the adoption of Ordinance No. A 07-9, adopted December 10, 2007; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners are obligated to reevaluate and reestablish the boundaries of the election within one year following the publication of the decennial census of the population of the United States;

**WHEREAS**, the 2010 United States Census has been published and a report of a redistricting committee has recommended to the Commissioners that the description of the boundaries of the election districts be modified to reflect the change and growth of the population of Bridgeville; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners of Bridgeville are desirous of reestablishing the election districts within the Town in accordance with Section 5, of Chapter 237, Volume 51, Laws of Delaware, relating to Elections.

### **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF BRIDGEVILLE:**

Section 1. Amend Bridgeville Code, Chapter 17, Article II, Election Districts, by deleting its text in its entirety and adding in lieu thereof the following:

#### **§ 17-15. Description of districts.**

A. There shall be five (5) representative districts in the Town of Bridgeville, as depicted on the map of the 2011 Election Districts for the Town of Bridgeville, attached hereto and made a part hereof, prepared by University of Delaware, dated ~~December~~, 2011. January 9, 2012.

B. The official 2011 Election District Map shall be identified by the signature of the President, attested by the Town Secretary, and bearing the Seal of the Town under the following words:

"This is to certify that this is the Official 2011 Election Districts Map referred to in Section 17-15, Chapter 17 of the Bridgeville Code and referred to in Section 1, of Ordinance No. A 11-6 of the Town of Bridgeville, adopted on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2012."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption by a majority of all members elected to the Commissioners of Bridgeville.


