

COMMISSIONERS MEETING
MAY 13, 1991
7:00 P.M.

PRESIDENT SLATER CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER AT 7:00 PM.

COMMISSIONERS PRESENT WERE GENE CROCKETT, JAMES EVANS,
CHARLES ROYAL, AND MICHAEL COLLISON.

COMMISSIONER COLLISON MADE A MOTION TO DISPENSE WITH THE
MINUTES FROM THE LAST REGULAR MEETING, SECOND BY
COMMISSIONER ROYAL. APPROVED.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY COMMISSIONER EVANS AND SECOND BY
COMMISSIONER CROCKETT TO PAY BILLS FOR LAST MONTH. APPROVED.

FOR APPROVAL THE COMMISSIONS STATED THAT THEY DID NOT HAVE
ENOUGH INFORMATION ON MR. MACKS APPLICATION FOR IT TO BE
APPROVED AT THIS TIME.

POLICE COMMISSIONER GENE CROCKETT AND HANDLEY ORR, POLICE
CHIEF GAVE AN UPDATE ON THE NEW POLICE STATION. THE BUILDING
IS ON SCHEDULE. THE PERSON WHO COMMITTED THE ARMED ROBBERY
LAST WEEK HAS BEEN APPREHENDED.

WWT COMMISSIONER MICHAEL COLLISON DID NOT HAVE ANYTHING TO
REPORT.

WATER COMMISSIONER JAMES EVANS STATED THAT WE ARE IN NEED OF
MORE WATER. EVANS WILL BE LOOKING INTO OPENING UP THE OLD
WELLS. LEON LIPPERT SPOKE ABOUT THE LOW WATER PRESURE AT HIS
APARTMENTS. DOUG JONES TOLD MR. LIPPERT TO REPLACE THE WATER
LINES GOING INTO THE APARTMENT HOUSE AND WE WILL LOOK INTO
REPLACING THE TOWN LINE. ON CANNON STREET THERE IS A PROBLEM
WITH A WATER METER STICKING TOO FAR OUT OF THE GROUND. THE
SUGGESTION WAS MADE TO PUT STONE AROUND THE METER WHERE THE
DIRT KEEPS WASHING AWAY.

STREET COMMISSIONER CHARLES ROYAL TOLD THE COMMISSIONER
ABOUT THE TRAFFIC CROSS LIGHT AT CANNON AND MARKET STREET.
THE CHIEF TRAFFIC ENGINEER HAS BEEN CONTACTED. THE OLDER
PEOPLE IN BRIDGEVILLE WOULD BE ABLE TO CROSS THE STREET.
COMM. ROYAL ALSO ASKED THE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT ABOUT HAVING A
PARADE ON THE FOURTH OF JULY. THIS WOULD BE A PROBLEM DUE TO
THE BEACH TRAFFIC. COMM. ROYAL ALSO SPOKE TO A COMPANY ABOUT
THE TRASH CANS. THE PRICE WOULD BE \$5.00 PER/MONTH.

COMMISSIONER EVANS ALSO TOLD THE COMMISSIONER THAT HE AND
DOUG NEED A CEMENT SLAB ADDED ONTO THE BUILDING AT THE
PLANT. THE PRICE WILL BE \$800.00.

HAS RECEIVED \$9,000.00 WORTH OF POLICE UNIFORMS FROM NEW

CASTLE POLICE DEPARTMENT. NEW CASTLE COUNTY PURCHASED NEW UNIFORMS AND DONATED THE UNIFORMS AND OFFICE EQUIPMENT TO THE TOWN OF BRIDGEVILLE. SGT. OATES MADE A PROPOSAL TO THE COMMISSIONERS TO PURCHASE ENOUGH TRICK OR TREAT BAGS TO DISTRIBUTE TO ALL OF THE CHILDREN AT THE ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS. IN ORDER FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO HAVE ENOUGH BAGS WE WILL NEED TO ORDER 1,000 BAGS. A MOTION WAS MADE BY COMMISSIONER CROCKETT AND SECOND TO COMMISSIONER ROYAL TO PURCHASE THE 1,000 BABS. APPROVED. ALL OF THE EQUIPMENT THAT IS NOT NEEDED HAS BEEN REMOVED FROM THE NEW POLICE DEPARTMENT. HOPEFULLY BY THE END OF APRIL THE INSIDE WILL BE READY FOR PAINTING. DALE WHEATLEY HAS BEEN AWARDED THE JOB OF THE PARKING LOT. THE RESTORATION OF THE BACK ROOM OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT WILL BE COVERED BY SALLEE FUND. DARYL TULL STATED THAT THE NEW POLICE DEPARTMENT IS ONE OF THE BEST THINGS THAT THE TOWN EVER HAS DONE. THERE ARE BIDS STILL OUT FOR THE ROOF AND OTHER REPAIRS. THERE ARE THREE BIDS OUT AT THIS TIME FOR THE HEAT AND AIR CONDITIONING.

WATER DEPARTMENT-COMMISSIONER EVANS STATED THAT HE HAS NOT HAD ANY REQUEST FOR METERS OTHER THAN THE REGULAR HOME METERS. IF ANYONE IS INTERESTED PLEASE CONTACT COMMISSIONER EVANS.

STREET COMMISSIONER-COMMISSIONER ROYAL STATED THAT HE HAS ORDERED THE NEW STREET SIGNS. THERE WERE NEW STREET LIGHTS INSTALED BY CANNON STREET, SCHOOL PARKING LIGHT.

PRESIDENT SLATER-THE RE-ZONING FOR THE APARTMENTS AT THE OLD IGA HAVE BEEN APPROVED. THE APARTMENT COMPLEX SHOULD BE UNDER CONSTRUCTION AT ANY TIME. THERE WAS A SPECIAL MEETING WITH ROBERT RIDER AND JOE CONAWAY ABOUT AN LP TANK FARM OUT BEHIND THE PERDUE FEED MILL. THE COMMISSIONERS VOTED NOT TO SUPPORT IT. THIS TANK WILL BE 800' FROM THE SCHOOL AND OUTSIDE OF THE TOWN LIMITS. THERE WAS A LETTER READ TO THE COMMISSIONER FROM JOB CONSTRUCTION. THEY HAVE PURCHASED 30 ACRES NORTH OF UNIVERSAL HOMES.

CITIZENS PRIVILEGE-DARYL TULL MADE THE COMMENT ABOUT AN ODOR FROM THE NEW CON-AGRA PLANT. MAYBE THE COMMISSIONERS SHOULD TAKE THIS INTO THE CONSIDERATION. THERE IS A PROBLEM WITH LAVERTY LANES, THE PEOPLE ARE USEING OTHER PEOPLES PROPERTY TO WALK ACROSS. DARYL MADE A SUGGESTION FOR THE COMMISSIONERS TO SEND A LETTER TO THE APARTMENTS TO TELL THE TENANTS NOT TO WALK OR RIDE ACROSS OTHER PEOPLES PROPERTY.

COMMISSIONER SLATER STATED THAT A LETTER WILL BE SENT TO CANTERBURY AND LAVERTY LANES IN REFERENCE TO THIS. THE POT HOLES ON CEDAR STREET ARE IN VERY BAD SHAPE. PHYLLIS JONES THANKED THE COMMISSIONERS FOR SUPPORTING EVERYONE IN THE TANK FARM. ALSO SHE SAID THAT THE SIGNS AT THE IGA PARKING LOT HAS HELPED ALOT. THERE IS STILL A PROBLEM WITH THE EXITING THAT NEEDS TO BE TAKEN CARE OF. MIKE LAYTON MADE THE SUGGESTION FOR THE PARKING TO BE

~~CHANGED ON MARKET STREET FROM THE SOUTH SIDE TO THE NORTH SIDE.~~ COMMISSIONER COLLISON STATED THAT CHUCK, DOUG AND PHILLIP SHOULD GO TO MARKET STREET AND MEASUR BOTH SIDES WITH A TAPE TO SEE IF WE WOULD GET MORE PARKING SPACES OUT OF THE NORTH SIDE. VERA SMACK MADE A SUGGESTION TO MAKE SOMETHING FOR THE CHILDREN TO DO THIS SUMMER. BRIDGEVILLE NEEDS A PLAYGROUND OR RECREATION FOR THE CHILDREN. THE TOWN ALSO NEEDS A PLCE FOR THE OLDER CHILDREN, THE PLAY GROUND WILL BE FINE FOR THE YOUNGER CHILDREN. VERA SUGGESTED A RECREATION BUILDING OR TO TAKE SUGGESTIONS FROM THE TEENAGE CHILDREN. A MOTION WAS MADE BY COMMISSIONER ROYAL TO MAKE COOPER ALLEY TO BE MADE TWO WAY TO ONE WAY. IT WILL RUN ONE WAY TO THE SOUTH, SECOND BY COMMISSIONER COLLISON. APPROVED.
