

COMMISSIONERS MEETING
NOVEMBER 11, 1991
7:00 P.M.

MEETING CALLED TO ORDER BY PRESIDENT SLATER AT 7:00 P.M.

COMMISSIONERS PRESENT WERE SLATER, EVANS, ROYAL AND CROCKETT.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY COMMISSIONER CROCKETT TO DISPENSE THE READING OF LAST MONTHS MINUTES AND SECOND BY COMMISSIONER EVANS. APPROVED.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY COMMISSIONER EVANS AND SECOND BY COMMISSIONER CROCKETT. APPROVED.

PRESIDENT SLATER READ A LETTER OF RESIGNATION FROM COMMISSIONER MICHAEL COLLISON. RESIGNATION EFFECTIVE DATE BY NOVEMBER 1991.

THERE WILL BE FOUR SEATS AVAILABLE FOR THE UP COMING ELECTION. THE POSITION FOR COMMISSIONER COLLISON WILL HAVE A ONE YEAR LEFT TO SERVE. THE ELECTION WILL BE ON JANUARY 6, 1991
AT THE BRIDGEMOUNT FIRE DEPARTMENT FROM 12:00 NOON UNTIL 7:00 P.M.

THE SECOND READING OF THE NOISE ORDINANCE. A MOTION WAS MADE BY COMMISSIONER ROYAL AND SECOND BY COMMISSIONER CROCKETT. APPROVED.

SHORE BEST UPDATE-THE COMMISSIONERS HAD A MEETING WITH THE REPRESENTATIVES IN OCTOBER. SHORE BEST WANTS THE SERVICES TO BE TURNED BACK ON. THE COMMISSIONERS RECEIVED A LETTER IN REFERENCE TO THIS. PRESIDENT SLATER STATED THAT HE IS AGAINST THEM COMING BACK ONTO LINE BEFORE THE UPGRADES HAVE BEEN MADE. HANS FROM DAVIS, BOWEN & FRIEDEL WAS PRESENT AT THE MEETING AND SPOKE ON THE BEHALF OF THE TOWN OF BRIDGEVILLE. HE ALSO HIGHLY RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSIONERS DO NOT EXCEPT SHORE BEST POULTRY'S TERMS.

COMMISSIONER CROCKETT GAVE THE POLICE DEPARMTNET REPORTS.

COMMISSIONER EVANS STATED THAT THE WATER SYSTEMS ARE OPERATING FAIRLY WELL.

COMMISSIONER ROYAL STATED THAT THE STATE HAS APPROVED THE CROSSWALKS FOR MARKET STREET. SIX TRASH CONTAINERS WILL BE INSTALLED ON MARKET STREET. AN EXIT SIGN WILL BE PUT AT THE IGA ON MARKET STREET.

BARBARA CHAFFINCH ASKED FOR THE EXIT AN ENTRANCE SIGNS TO BE INSTALLED AT THE IGA BUILDING. SHE FEELS THAT BOTH OF THE

DRIVEWAYS SHOULD BE MADE ENTRANCES IN AND FOR THE TRAFFIC TO EXIT THROUGH THE ALLEY BEHIND THE STORE. THE ARROWS WILL BE INSTALLED.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY COMMISSIONER ROYAL TO INSTALL THE ARROWS AND THE ALLEY WILL BE THE ENTRANCE AND THE PARKING LOT WILL BE THE EXIT. THE ALLEY WAY WILL BE ONE WAY. (JOHN STREET) MOTION SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER CROCKETT. APPROVED. BARBARA ALSO ASKED THE COMMISSIONERS ABOUT THE PEOPLE WHO LIVE OUT OF TOWN LIMITS BEING ABLE TO VOTE. IN BETHANY BEACH THE PROPERTY OWNERS CAN VOTE.
