NEW BUSINESS:

Heritage Shores Phase 7 Concept Plan and RPC Amendment

Dustin Rauch of Rauch Inc. was present via Zoom. Mr. Rauch presented this Concept Plan and informed that this Phase will be age restricted consisting of 87 lots, seven 60 foot single family detached, twenty-eight 50 foot single family detached, and thirty-two 35 foot wide duplex lots. Mr. Rauch explained the change in the number of single family and duplex homes was in response to demand. Mr. Rauch informed the house types, setbacks, Homeowner's Association and Special Tax District will be consistent with previous phases. B. DeBussy asked what the street name would be and if the water line could be looped in. Mr. Rauch stated the name of the road has not been finalized and he will look into looping the water line. Jason Loar of Davis, Bowen & Friedel stated a closer look at the water line would be done at the final review. Lauren Good of Wallace Montgomery stated the concern she had was explained.
