

REGULAR MEETING

SEPTEMBER 10, 1990

7:00 P.M.

The regular meeting of the Commissioners of Bridgeville was brought to order by President Gilefski at 7:00 pm. Present were Commissioners Tull, Willey, Slater and Evans. Guest present were John Loscomb, Doug Jones, Chief Orr, Phillip Mowbray, Frankie Adams, Steve Heder

A motion was then made by Commissioner Willey, second by Commissioner Slater. So approved. Minutes are available for public view at any time.

Bills were presented for payment . After review by all commissioners, a motion was made to pay all bills. So approved.

Commissioner Gilefski then made it aware to the other Commissioners about the pension plan being paid. They were each given sheets to show the amount that were paid through Mrs. Pusey.

Commissioner Gilefski then read a letter sent to us commending Phillip Mowbray and Doug Jones on thier efforts to repair the sewer line leak in the road on Main Street. The Department of Transportation has recommended that we replace the water and sewer lines to prevent this and other leaks from happening in the future.

Commissioner Gilefski then stated that he has spoken to Jerry Jones at the Delaware State Housing Authority and they are trying to set a deadline for occupancy, either Oct. 1, Or Nov.1. The fence is in and it should be installed soon.

Commissioner Gilefski then pointed out that the Alderman's report was done by Kathy Lingo to show what is going on in the court besides the number of traffic violations.

Commissioners Report-Police, Commissioner Tull passed out police report for the month of Aug. He stated that our policemen are doing a good job with the traffic. Commissioner Tull also presented pictures that the Police Dept. had taken of the hole in the sewer line when we had the leak. The pictures can be used and enclosed in the letter to the state for assistance on replacing the line.

Sewer Report-Commissioner Evans stated that Phil and John both attended a workshop at Milford to benefit our plant. They will presenting figures at the next meeting on covering the glass building at the plant before winter. The grass

around the plant has also been keeping them busy. John Loscomb stated that he is still waiting on Brian on the conatours. They are 25 years old. The seals are bad. The line on Church Street from Greenwood has been brought into town . However they have not completed the crossovers. There is still work to be done before completion.


Commissioner Willey then asked if anyone had any water leaks to please be patient since Doug and Phil are trying to catch up.

Steve Heder-Would like to know when town clean up day is going to be. Commissioner Slater said that he needs to speak to Mr. Rizzo.
