

Commissioner Meeting
Sept. 9, 1991
7:00 P.M.

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by President Slater.

Commissioners present were Comm. Collison, Comm. Royal, Comm. Evans, Comm. Crockett.

Guest present were Daryl Tull, Joe Willey, George Hardesty, G.L. Steinmetz, John Loscomb, Phillip Mowbray, Doug Jones, Diane Willey, Chief Orr.

A motion was made to dispense with the minutes from the previous regular meeting. Motion made by Commissioner Evans and second by Commissioner Collison. Approved.

The Bridgeville Historical Society donated prints to the Town of Bridgeville which are hanging in the Town Hall. The Commissioners' would like to thank the Historical Society for the prints.

Commissioner Collison stated that we have received an application for a private hauler from S&R Sanitation. They are a private hauler for sanitary waste. Approx. 1,500 gallons per load, he estimates 4 to 6 loads per month. A motion was made by Commissioner Collison and second by Commissioner Royal for a one year permit. Approved.

Commissioner Evans stated that as soon as the upgrade has been done every thing will be taken care of with requests.

Commissioner Royal stated that we have started patching some pot holes. Hopefully this will last until we can completely re-surface the streets. The town will have trash dispensers put within the town as soon as the order comes.

Commissioner Collison stated that Kidde Consultants are presently looking at the upgrades for the ultra violet system at the sewer plant. They were asked to please respond to our situation as rapidly as possible.

Commissioner Crockett stated that the traffic arrest this month are up to 833. The town police traveled 4,453 miles in the month of August. The average for each patrolmen would be 395 miles. Also the open house for the new police station will be set tonight. The open house will be October 5, 6 1991. The time will be 12:00 to 4:00. The address is 302 Market Street and is the former Baltimore Trust building. Also Commissioner Crockett asked about the meetings about

the re routing truck traffic through town. Commissioner Royal said that the police department can stop every truck

that comes through the town. Some of the other towns have started setting noise, weight limitations. The department of tran. should put a sign up for the truck traffic to tell them how to get to the beach. Commissioner Collison request that the Commissioners' send another letter to DelDot.

The Commissioner had a meeting to discuss new town engineers. Tonight the Commissioners will decide in executive session if we will hire the new engineers.

Carol Gasior asked if the library request had been received by the Commissioners. Daryl Tull asked about the housing complex. He wanted to know why we have to give water and sewer to the Delmarva Ministries. The south side of town is overloaded. The residents feel that they should know what is going on. There are petitions being passed around town against the housing complex. This will not be inside of the town limits.

A motion was made by Commissioner Collison and second by Commissioner Evans to go into executive session.

The Commissioners came back out of executive session at 9:15 P.M. The new town engineering form for approval will be Bowen, Davis & Friedel. Motion made by Commissioner Crockett and second by Commissioner Evans. Approved. Commissioner Collison goes on record as sustaining from that vote. Four (4) in favor.

A motion was made by Commissioner Crockett and second by Commissioner Evans to promote Cpl. Parsons to Sgt. Approved. With salary pending employee approval.

A motion was made to pay the 85% of the employees BC/BS and the employees paying the other 15% by Commissioner Evans and second by Commissioner Royal. This will be reviewed on a yearly bases. Approved.
