

COMMISSIONERS MEETING
APRIL 8, 1991
7:00 PM

MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY PRESIDENT SLATER AT 7:00 PM.

COMMISSIONERS PRESENT WERE SLATER, CROCKETT, COLLISON, EVANS AND ROYAL.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY COMMISSIONER COLLISON TO DISPENSE WITH THE READING OF THE MINUTES FROM THE LAST REGULAR MEETING WITH A SECOND BY COMMISSIONER CROCKETT. APPROVED.

BILLS WERE PRESENTED FOR PAYMENT, AFTER A BRIEF REVIEW OF ALL OF THE COMMISSIONERS A MOTION WAS MADE BY COMMISSIONER EVANS AND SECOND BY COMMISSIONER ROYAL. APPROVED.

PRESIDENT SLATER STATED THAT THE PROPERTY OF LEBANON CHEMICAL. A LARGE COMPANY MAY BE PURCHASING THE PROPERTY FOR A NEW PLANT TO EMPLOY UP TO 350 PEOPLE.

THERE WAS A PLANNING MEETING FOR THE COMMISSIONERS AND PRESIDENT SLATER STATED ALL OF THE DISCUSSIONS THAT TOOK PLACE. COMMISSIONER COLLISON TOLD THE PEOPLE OF THE UPDATE OF SHORE BEST POULTRY, INC. THERE WILL BE PLANS PRESENTED TO THE TOWN ON THE TYPE OF WASTE THAT THEY WILL BE GENERATING AND A PRETREATMENT SYSTEM. DARYL TULL TOLD THE COMMISSIONERS THAT THERE IS STILL A PROBLEM WITH SHORE BEST POULTRY, INC. MCMULLEN SEPTIC SYSTEM HAS BEEN PUMPING OUT SHORE BEST AND DUMPING THE WASTE ONTO A FIELD SOUTH OF BRIDGEVILLE. THE COMMISSIONERS AGREED THAT A LETTER MUST BE SENT TO THE DNREC IN REFERENCE TO THIS. COMMISSIONER COLLISON STATED THAT HE BELIEVES THAT MR. SCOTT SHOULD BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR HIS SEWERAGE PUMPS BURNING UP THE DAY THAT THE AGREEMENT WAS SIGNED. COMMISSIONER COLLISON MADE A MOTION THAT THE TOWN WILL NOT PAY ANY BILLS INCURRED BY THE BRIDGEVILLE PLAZA IN REFERENCE TO THE PUMPS. THE MOTION WAS SECOND BY COMMISSIONER EVANS. APPROVED.

SIMMONS CABLE TV HAS A RECEIVING TOWER ON OUR WATER TOWER. SIMMONS WOULD LIKE FOR THE COMMISSIONERS TO SIGN A RENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THEM. A MOTION WAS MADE BY COMMISSIONER COLLISON, MOTION DIED WITH NO SECOND. DARYL TULL MADE A SUGGESTION TO CHECK ON THE PRICE THAT SIMMONS IS PAYING THE TOWN FOR RENTAL. COMMISSIONER ROYAL WILL CHECK FOR COMPETATIVE PRICES.

PRESIDENT SLATER TOLD THE COMMISSIONER THAT THE NEWS LETTER IS ON THE WAY.

CITIZENS PRIVILEGE-MAY 16TH BRIDGEVILLE WILL HAVE MAY DAY AT THE LIBRARY. THE FLAGS HANGING IN TOWN NEED TO BE CLEANED AND REPLACED WHENEVER POSSIBLE.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY COMMISSIONER EVANS AND SECOND BY COMMISSIONER COLLISON TO GO INTO EXECUTIVE SESSION.

THE COMMISSIONERS CAME OUT OF THE EXECUTIVE SESSION AND WENT BACK INTO REGULAR SESSION AT 8:10 P.M.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY COMMISSIONER COLLISON TO HIRE MR. WILLIE ROBERTS, JR. AS THE NEW ALDERMAN AT A RATE OF \$7.50 PER/HR. AND \$14.00 PER/HOUR FOR CALL INS. THE MOTION WAS SECOND BY COMMISSIONER ROYAL. APPROVED.
