

COMMISSIONERS OF BRIDGEVILLE
REGULAR MEETING
AUGUST 13, 1973

Meeting called to order by President Powell at 8:00 P.M.
Commissioners Gray, Jones, Simons and Willey were present.

Mrs. Helen Griffith, Office Manager, American Original Foods with a delegation request improvements he made to parking facilities for their employees' cars. Mr. Powell tried to explain the situation so merchants and American Original employees can be placated. Mr. Jones and Mr. Gray also voiced their opinions concerning parking. The commissioners will try to solve this problem as soon as possible.

Mr. Dan C. Ross of CATV General Corporation attended the meeting. Mr. Powell had written Mr. Ross requesting progress he had made in installing CATV in Bridgeville for contract of Dec. 29, 1972. Mr. Ross explained the problems involved in making installation. He explained that one particular installation has caused delays in installing 5 Or 6 other franchies. Now the problems have been solved and progress should be made now even though they are 6 months behind schedule. Mr. Ross asked for a 6 months delay in fulfilling this contract. Motion made, seconded, and approved unanimously that we grant CATV General Corp. 6 months extention on original contract dated Dec. 29, 1972. Mr. Ross will send or deliver amendment to be signed by Commissioners.
